## **Battle For Broxton Bridge**

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- I. All participants are required to:
  - · Conform to rules and regulations as expressed by the event staff.
  - Follow orders of the prospective commanders.
  - Portray life and military scenes consistent to the period.
- 2. All participants are required to provide all information requested on all registration forms and to provide any proof of verification.
- 3. All campfires are to be in fire pits and no fires are to be left unattended at any time. All camps are required to be kept clean and to be inspected by the Unit Officer before leaving the complex. Trash containers and pick-up are available. Please use the amenities wisely so that everyone may have enough.
- 4. Camps are required to conform to period presentation while the camps are open to the public and are subject to inspection. Otherwise, from morning parade thru the evening retiring of the colors, you are in the I860's.
- 5. All persons under the age of 16 must be accompanied by the parent or guardian (the guardian must have a signed, notarized statement from the custodial parent). The event staff is not responsible for any accidents, activities or conduct of any participant. Please, do not drop off your kids at the camps and expect the participants to baby-sit.
- 6. All participants under the age of 14 must have clearance from the on-site commanders (Infantry, Artillery, Cavalry) to participate in the Battle. Participants under the age of 14 will not be allowed to carry weapons. Exceptions are as follows: If the participant shows they are proficient with their weapon and their parent is in the ranks with them they may participate. This is decided on a case-by-case basis.
- 7. All participants are required to practice safety standards for any activities while in the complex.
- 8. Possession or consumption of illegal substances or possession of illegal items is strictly prohibited and will result in eviction and/or legal actions. Excessive use of alcohol is also prohibited.
- 9. All generators are required to be shut off from 12:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.
- 10. All participants and guests (pets and animals must be on a leash) are required to keep off the embankments. This will help ensure its preservation for the future.

## Military Regulations

- I. All weapons will be inspected for authenticity and safety.
- 2. All participants will be subject to inspection for authenticity of uniforms and accessories.
- 3. All military equipment (uniforms, firearms, accessories, etc.) should conform to the represented time period 1840-1865 and is subject to approval by the Battle for Broxton Committee or on-site Commanders.
- 4. Non-compliance of any of the rules or regulations may result in the dismissal of the participant from any activity or expulsion from the complex.
- 5. All quiet at 11:00 p.m. each night.
- 6. Vehicles are only permitted for loading and unloading (please keep this to a minimum). ALLVEHICLES ARE TO BE OUT OF THE CAMPS BY 7:30 A.M. SATURDAY.
- 7. Vehicles will be allowed in the camps on Saturday AFTER the Battle and camps are close to public (5 PM) but must be removed by 11:00 p.m.
  - NO RAMRODS ARE TO BE PULLED BY ANYONE EXCEPT OFFICERS OR SENIOR NCO'S OF THE RESPECTIVE UNITS. Failure to comply with these Regulations will result in expulsion from the complex.
